

UK Localization Map

Priority supports all standard ERP functionalities as well as the preparation of the VAT Report for submission to HMRC.

This document summarizes all **Priority**'s localization features for businesses in the UK. (To view the general EU localization features, please refer to the **EU Localization Map** in the [Xpert Knowledge Base](#).)

To enable localization features, make sure to:

- Purchase the **UK Module**, No. M2002.
- Purchase the **Module – British English (Only!) Dictionary**, No. 1050B, if you want to ensure that your system displays UK and not American English.

Note: Download the dictionary module from the Xpert [Downloads](#) page.

- Purchase the **Find Address – UK** module, No. 1167, if you want to use **Priority**'s address lookup tool.
- Select the United Kingdom as the country when installing **Priority**. For new installations, a preconfigured data template will define the required system parameters for working in the UK, such as VAT groups, VAT codes, and other financial settings.

UK Environment Setup

VAT Reporting

From version 19.0, **Priority** supports the calculation and reporting of VAT to HMRC in the Making Tax Digital (MTD) format. For instructions, refer to the [UK VAT Report \(with MTD\)](#) SOP to define VAT codes and percentages, set up VAT report definitions, set up a VAT reverse charge, sign up for the MTD service, run the VAT report, and submit a return.

From version 21.0, as part of our commitment to your success in navigating Brexit, we've converted the UK VAT report (**Value Added Tax**) to the **VAT Report (by Boxes)** (path: **Financials > General Ledger > Financial Statements > Taxes > VAT Reports**).

The **VAT Report (by Boxes)** uses our flexible VAT Report Generator, which allows you to easily define which transactions contribute to the sums in the VAT report boxes, according

to the requirements that may arise from Brexit (such as whether or not to use the new PVA regulation in imports).

Priority supports Bacs payment transfers to vendors in the UK through Finastra.

Address Lookup by Postcode

The address lookup feature fills in customer or vendor addresses by their post code, and is available in most **Priority** forms that include the **Post Code** field. The [Address Lookup by Postcode](#) SOP describes how to use this feature and the setups required before doing so.

Plastic Packaging Tax

Priority supports working with the Plastic Packaging Tax that came into effect in the UK as of April 1, 2022. In version 22.1 this feature is available out of the box. In versions 20.1 to 22.0, this feature is available as an add-on.

This tax is relevant for:

- UK manufacturers of plastic packaging
- importers of plastic packaging
- business customers of manufacturers/importers of plastic packaging
- consumers who buy plastic packaging or goods in plastic packaging in the UK

An exemption is made for manufacturers and importers of less than 10 tons of plastic packaging per year.
